

CONTRIBUTION TO BUKIT MERTAJAM HOSPITAL & KEK LOK SI CHARITABLE HOSPITAL IN COLLABORATION WITH BUDDHIST TZU-CHI MERITS SOCIETY MALAYSIA (TZU-CHI)

As Malaysia continues to battle against the pandemic, Texchem Resources Bhd, through its partnership with Tzu-Chi donated 6,000 pieces of face shields to the frontliners of Bukit Mertajam Hospital. Bukit Mertajam Hospital is a government hospital which was converted into a Covid-19 ward last month following the spike in Covid cases in Penang. The face shields were handed over on our behalf by Dato' Khoo Boo Leong, Tzu-Chi's commissioner to Dr. Goh Hin Kwang, Director of Bukit Mertajam Hospital on 5 August 2021.

On 6 August 2021, Texchem Resources Bhd contributed 10,000 face masks and 200 face shields to Kek Lok Si Charitable Hospital (KLSCH).
