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PRESIDENT & GROUP CEO'S MESSAGE

REFLECTING ON QUARTER 4 AND EMBRACING OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROWTH IN THE NEW YEAR 2024

Dear Texchemers,

As we conclude Quarter 4 of 2023, I find it pertinent to engage in thoughtful reflection on our collective journey throughout the past year and lay the groundwork for our aspirations in the coming year.

In 2023, midst its array of challenges and successes, it's imperative to recognize that, as an organization, we encountered a lapse in our responsiveness to economic shifts. The reasons behind this setback are complex and multifaceted, but it is crucial that we transform these experiences into opportunities for growth and learning.

These challenges continued to weigh on the financial performance of the Group. For the financial year ended 31 December 2023 (FY23), we delivered a revenue of RM993.5 million versus RM1,143.3 million a year ago. This was largely due to lower sales on the back of high interest rate and inflation coupled with inventory adjustments in certain industries that we serve. The situation was further compounded by a rise in input, operating costs and higher tax expenses, which led to a net loss of RM10.8 million for FY23, which included share-based payments amounting to RM3.0 million.

Looking ahead, our core focus remains on the strategic plans we have in place. For our Industrial Division, we are putting more focus to bulk chemicals to grow revenue while at the same time explore opportunities to strengthen our position in the value chain. As for the Polymer Engineering Division, we are not only pleased to see continued improvement in the sectors that we serve but also had successfully commenced mass production in **Q4 2023** for certain strategic projects which we had been pursuing since

2022. For the Food Division, the focal point will be on growing the local market in Myanmar and diversifying our supply chain from Myanmar. Lastly, for our Restaurant Division, we continue to focus on growing our presence in East Coast states and East Malaysia. Simultaneously, we are also enhancing our cost management to optimise our cost structure.

As we stand on the cusp of 2024, our central message remains steadfast: "Follow Through and Just Deliver." These aren't mere catchphrases but guiding principles that will shape our collective actions and propel us towards new heights of success. Let us heed the lessons of 2023, rise above any setbacks, and collectively strive to make 2024 a year marked by substantial achievements.

Despite the challenges we faced, your dedication and hard work have not gone unnoticed. Each one of you has played a pivotal role in steering Texchem through the complexities of the past year. Your commitment is the bedrock upon which we build our shared success.

As the New Year beckons, I extend my heartfelt wishes to you and your loved ones. May 2024 be a year of renewed focus, growth, and prosperity. Let us bid farewell to the complacency of the past and embrace the myriad opportunities that lie ahead, poised to shape our future.

The exclusive audience, comprising esteemed guests, experienced an intimate and captivating concert, forging a deep connection between performers and attendees.





Originally, the Loy Krathong tradition is believed to have begun during the Sukhothai period, under the reign of King Ramkhamhaeng, with Mrs. Noppamas or Thao Sri Chulalak being credited as the first inventor of the Krathong.









Objectives of Loy Krathong

Loy Krathong serves two main objectives:

Worshiping the Buddha:

In some localities, Loy Krathong is considered a way to worship the Buddha, commemorating the occasion when the Buddha performed dhamma in *Nagaphipop* and imprinted His footprint on the banks of the *Nammtanti River* during the twelfth full moon night. In this spirit, Texchem actively participates in Loy Krathong, joining the Thai community in expressing reverence for this significant event.

In the northern part of Thailand, there is also the *Yipeng* tradition, where both Loy Krathong and lanterns are released into the sky to worship the Buddha, believed to be contained in the Heavenly Chulamani.

Fire Drill & ERT Training TXPM

A fire drill is a mandatory requirement for all commercial and public buildings in Malaysia, with strict regulations governing their conduct. Failure to comply can result in severe penalties imposed by **Jabatan Bomba & Penyelamat Malaysia (JBPM).** Additionally, all buildings must adhere to the *fire certificate (FC)* requirements during annual FC renewals.

Texchem-Pack (M) Sdn Bhd (TXPM) conducted a fire drill session on November 1, 2023. The drill involved employees from TXPM and TXPO (Texchem Polymers Sdn Bhd). At approximately 9:40 a.m., the fire alarm was triggered, prompting immediate evacuation from the company building. Employees assembled at the designated emergency point, awaiting further instructions from the Emergency Response Team (ERT).

After ensuring the safe evacuation of all team members, each department received briefings on the application of the fire alarm and monitoring systems. These explanations were crucial for employees to understand how to react during a fire emergency and the potential negative impacts on company property and lives.

They were briefed on the location of the main fire alarm panel system at the guardhouse, how to respond to the fire alarm panel during an emergency, the **CO2** panel and its system location in every electrical room (*TNB room*). Additionally, ERT members were briefed about the fire pump house, containing three types of pumps (*Jockey, Duty, Standby*), and its functionality, primarily to pump water into the sprinkler system during a fire emergency.

We express our gratitude to every employee who participated in this fire drill, especially our ERT members who successfully planned a series of activities. We hope that this drill will benefit everyone in their response to any fire incidents in the company.


